FREE VB MAPP TRAINING

COURSE DESCRIPTION

In this one-day, in-person training, participants will learn how to use the VB-MAPP assessment and administer the test. The VB-MAPP is a criterion-referenced assessment, curriculum guide, and skill-tracking system for children with autism or language delays. It has five components:

1. Milestones Assessment – measures 170 verbal and related skills across three developmental levels (0–18, 18–30, and 30–48 months), including mand, tact, echoic, intraverbal, listener, play, social, visual-perceptual, classroom, and early academic skills. It includes the Early Echoic Skills Assessment (EESA).
2. Barriers Assessment – evaluates 24 common learning and language barriers (e.g., behavior problems, poor generalization, social deficits).
3. Transition Assessment – assesses readiness for less restrictive educational settings and supports IEP decision-making.
4. Task Analysis and Skills Tracking – provides detailed skill breakdowns and ongoing curriculum guidance.
5. Placement and IEP Goals – aligns assessment results with placement decisions and IEP goal development.
