

## **Functional Tasks**

#### 1. TASK BOXES

Task boxes are a great foundational and routine activity to have in your classroom. They are not intended to teach new skills but to create tasks based off of mastered skills and create independent work routines with learners. We base task boxes off of skills that are critical vocational skills such as matching, sorting, fine motor, assembly, packaging, filing and labeling.
