WHY DO WE NEED INDEPENDENT WORK SYSTEMS?

Functional tasks and work systems can teacher...

- Independence
- Communication
- Functional skills
- Vocational Skills
- Following Schedules and Routines
- Transitioning from one task to another Functional tasks and work systems can also benefit the teacher and other students in the class.
 - Allows time for the teacher to work with other students
 - Provides structure and ready to use tasks that can be reused from day to day.





SETTING UP A WORK SYSYEM

Work systems can be flexible and do not have to be done any certain way, however, here are a few things to keep in mind that can help students be more successful and independent.

- Visual supports:
 - Visual schedule
 - Task analysis of how to complete task
 - Check in zone
- Accessibility:
 - Are your students going to get the tasks themselves? Will they go retrieve their own tasks?
- Storage:
 - Drawers
 - Bins
 - Picture boxes
- Work Space:
 - Will students have a particular work space for task boxes or will they take them back to their desks?


TEACH THE LEARNER

- 1. Introduce the schedule of tasks
- 2. Show leaner where to retrieve tasks.
- 3. Prompt learner by standing behind or to the side
- 4. Be consistent using concise and relevant words, gestures, or images
- 5. Assist learner through steps of schedule
- 6. Model communication needed for help and finished
- 7. Provide positive praise and reinforcement as the complete the parts of the schedule.
- 8. Repeat steps as needed



REMINDERS

- These systems take time to develop and create
- The skill of using these systems must be TAUGHT
 - What to do when you need help or when you are finished
 - Where to start, obtain boxes, complete a visual schedule
- The work systems are intended to promote independent work
